TURN YOUR **STATE FFA DEGREE**
INTO **SIX COLLEGE CREDITS**
AT **MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY**

Since 2015, an agreement between the Michigan Department of Education and Michigan State University has recognized the achievement of State FFA Degree recipients by awarding eligible students six general university credits toward a bachelor's degree or undergraduate certificate program at Michigan State University.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

To receive six general university credits, you must:

- ✓ Complete a State-Approved AFNRE Program
- ✓ Earn the State FFA Degree
- ✓ Be admitted to Michigan State University



DON'T FORGET

Include a copy of your **State FFA Degree certificate** when submitting your verification form. Your request cannot be processed without it.

MISSING YOUR STATE DEGREE CERTIFICATE?

If you can't find your State FFA Degree Certificate, you can request a verification letter from the Michigan FFA Office. Email association@michiganffa.org and include: your full name, FFA Chapter, and year you received the State Degree.

HOW TO RECEIVE YOUR CREDITS?

- 1 Enroll at Michigan State University**
Be admitted to an undergraduate degree or certificate program at MSU.
- 2 Complete the Verification Form**
Download and fill out the State FFA Degree Credit Verification Form with the required information and signatures.
- 3 Submit Your Documentation**
Send the completed form and a copy of your State FFA Degree certificate to the MSU Registrar's Office or submit them electronically to reg@msu.edu.
- 4 Apply Your Credits**
Work with your academic advisor to determine how your six general university credits will apply toward your degree or certificate program.

Students that are “program completers” in a State Approved AFNR Ed Program and are State FFA degree recipients that have been admitted into a bachelor’s degree program or an undergraduate certificate program at MSU will earn six general university credits (GCU) on their MSU transcript that will count toward their program total credit requirement.

This applies to incoming freshman students or transfer students that graduated in the 2014-2015 academic year or after.
